

Audition Outcomes

BA (Hons) Dance (Contemporary)

When will I find out if I have been offered a place?

1. We make our first shortlist on the audition day, as outlined in our **Audition Information**, and those who are not asked to remain for the last section of the day will unfortunately not be offered a place. Please note that at the audition for **BA (Hons) Dance (Contemporary)** the audition panel will automatically consider you for the **Access to Higher Education Diploma: Contemporary Dance** if they feel that this would be a better course for you at this stage. *You do not need to make a separate application or attend another audition.*
2. Applicants who are shortlisted to remain for the full day will be provided with details about a short written task, in relation to the audition, to be submitted within 1 week from the audition day.
3. Approximately 3 weeks after your audition day you will receive an email with your audition outcome. This will be either
 - a) An offer of a place, conditional upon submission of the entry requirements (The offer letter, information and the acceptance form will be attached to the email), or
 - b) A place on our reserve list (see explanation below), or
 - c) Notification that unfortunately you will not be offered a place.

If I'm offered a place how long will I have to decide?

Your offer letter will state the date by which you have to respond and will be approximately 3 weeks from the offer date. If, for any reason you are unable to commit by this date you will be transferred to the reserve list and considered again if a place becomes available. A non-refundable registration fee of £150 will be payable with your acceptance form.

How does your reserve list work?

We keep a reserve list of applicants who we may potentially wish to offer a place to but in fairness to those attending later auditions we will make our final decision after the last audition. At this point you will be contacted again with either an offer of a place, conditional upon submission of the entry requirements, or notification that you will remain on our reserve list with offers being made should a place become available. It is possible that places may become available anytime up until September. Should a place become available, the selected person to fill the place will be contacted as soon as possible on the telephone number you provided or by email. Unfortunately we are unable to predict the likelihood of this or enter into correspondence regarding placing on the reserve list.

Can I audition again?

You can't audition again in the same year but we welcome applicants to apply and audition the following year.

Can I get feedback from my audition?

On request, by emailing admissions@nscd.ac.uk, we can provide standardised feedback based on the scores that the panel awarded you for each section of the audition. If you were shortlisted on the audition day this will only be available after the audition outcomes have been decided.
