Stage 1: Making Your Application

To make your online application you will be required to enter / upload the items below. We are unable to process applications with all the requested items.

- 1. Personal Details (name, contact details etc)
- 2. Most recent place of education
- 3. Highest qualification level you expect to have completed by course entry
- 4. Your highest qualification course title
- 5. **Your Curriculum Vitae (CV)** (to upload 8MB max file size)
- 6. **Filmed footage / showreel** (a video link, 5 minutes minimum 10 minutes maximum) Your showreel should include examples of your work that best reflect the breadth of your interests as an artist. This may include your creative work, your performance work, your solo work and/or your improvisation work. For example:
 - Your choreographic work.
 - Extract from a durational performance directed and/or performed by you.

*Footage can be filmed on your phone – professional filming is not required. To insert your video links:

- 1. Log in to a personal YouTube account and click 'create' to upload your edited showreel footage.
- 2. Make sure you set the 'Visibility' setting to 'unlisted' (rather than public or private).
- 3. Once the video is uploaded, click 'share', copy the links and paste into the online application form. Please do not delete the video from your account until you have received an audition outcome.
- 7. A Written Personal Statement of 1000-1500 words to include the following areas:
 - What is your approach, as an artist, to the production of your work? This could include concepts, identity, ideas, the structures and form you apply and the production.
 - If this work was to translate from the studio to a small-scale production what are the issues for consideration that you need to think about in terms of being an artist who is now also a producer?
 This could include project management, resources, funding and marketing.
 - Your reasons for applying to this course.

Please use references of current theories of practice to support your writing and include a reference page or bibliography in a Harvard style.
