

Audition Outcomes

MA Contemporary Dance Performance (VERVE and/or PAS)

When will I find out if I have been offered a place?

1. We make our first shortlist on the audition day or, for VERVE, after viewing a 'remote' audition. You will then be told on the audition day, or by email, if you are to be invited to the recall auditions. *Please note that shortlisted VERVE applicants who attend overseas auditions or submit a remote audition are not required to attend the VERVE recall audition but are welcome to attend if possible. You will still be considered alongside the other shortlisted applicants.*

2. Recall Auditions

After the first round auditions shortlisted candidates may be invited to attend either or both:

- The VERVE recall audition
- The PAS company recall auditions

Shortlisted applicants for both VERVE & PAS will also be required to bring a copy of their CV to hand to the company at each recall audition.

Please see the **Audition Types, Venues and Dates** information on the How to Apply/postgraduate page of the website for the dates. Those who are shortlisted to attend the PAS Company Recalls will receive an email with the specific dates, times and locations and will be asked to book on the auditions they wish to attend. Approximately 1 week after your VERVE recall audition or the PAS final company audition you will receive an email with your audition outcome. This will be either:

- a) An offer of a place, conditional upon submission of the entry requirements (The offer letter, information and the acceptance form link will be attached to the email), or
- b) A place on our reserve list (see explanation below), or
- c) Notification that unfortunately you will not be offered a place. *If you also applied for the MA Dance & Creative Enterprise you will still be eligible to make a submission for that course.*

When will I find out if I have been offered a place?

Approximately 1 week after your submission you will receive an email with your outcome. This will be either:

- a) An offer of a place, conditional upon submission of the entry requirements (The offer letter, information and the acceptance form link will be attached to the email), or
- b) A place on our reserve list (see explanation below), or
- c) Notification that unfortunately you will not be offered a place.

If I'm offered a place how long will I have to decide?

Your offer letter will state the date by which you have to respond and will be approximately 1 week from the offer date. If, for any reason you are unable to commit by this date you will be transferred to the reserve list and considered again if a place becomes available. A non-refundable registration fee of £150 will be payable with your acceptance form.

How does your reserve list work?

We keep a reserve list of applicants who we may potentially wish to offer a place. It is possible that places may become available anytime up until September. Should a place become available, the selected person to fill the place will be contacted as soon as possible on the telephone number you provided or by email. Unfortunately we are unable to predict the likelihood of this or enter into correspondence regarding placing the reserve list.

Can I audition again?

You can't audition again in the same year but we welcome applicants to apply and audition the following year.

Can I get feedback from my audition?

On request, by emailing admissions@nscd.ac.uk, we can provide standardised feedback based on the scores that the panel awarded you for each section of the audition. If you were shortlisted on the audition day this will only be available after the audition outcomes have been decided.

An applicant cannot appeal a decision reached by the audition panel. For information regarding the admissions process please refer to the Northern School of Contemporary Dance Admissions Policy.
