Dance Online provides over 1000 hours of dance footage covering a vast range of genres and styles. The database is also known as Dance in Video I & II.

Who can access Dance Online

All students and staff at BOVTS, CSB, LCDS, NCCA, NSCD & Rambert.

How can Laccess Dance Online?

Students and staff across the conservatoire can access Dance Online directly on any networked computer at their school. Simply go to http://search.alexanderstreet.com/daiv and you will automatically be logged into the database.

You can also access the database off-site on any computer with internet access via an online gateway called OpenAthens. You will need a username and password to log into OpenAthens @ http://www.openathens.net/



You can also log into OpenAthens by following the 'OpenAthens' link at the bottom of the CDD & NSCD websites.



How do I get a username and password to access OpenAthens?

From a networked school computer, go to http://www.cdd.ac.uk/students/library-resources/ and scroll down to the OpenAthens section.

Here you can register, log in, renew and reset your password for your OpenAthens Account. Accounts must be set up using your school email address which will act as your username.

How do I watch a video?







Hover over your chosen video and click See Details

Click the Play icon to start the video






What can I watch on Dance Online?


