Dance Online provides over 1000 hours of dance footage covering a vast range of genres and styles. The database is also known as Dance in Video I & II.


Who can access Dance Online

How can I access Dance Online?

Students and staff across the conservatoire can access Dance Online directly on any networked computer at their school. Simply go to <http://search.alexanderstreet.com/daiv> and you will automatically be logged into the database.

You can also access the database off-site on any computer with internet access via an online gateway called OpenAthens. You will need a username and password to log into OpenAthens @ <http://www.openathens.net/>



You can also log into OpenAthens by following the 'OpenAthens' link at the bottom of the CDD & NSCD websites.



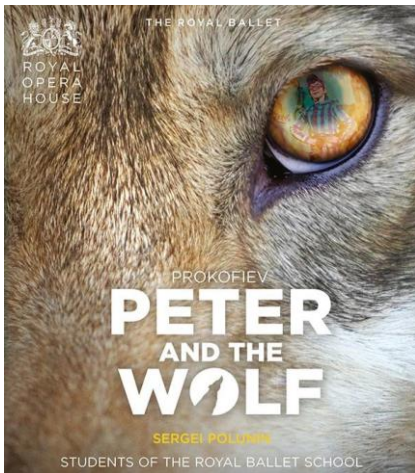

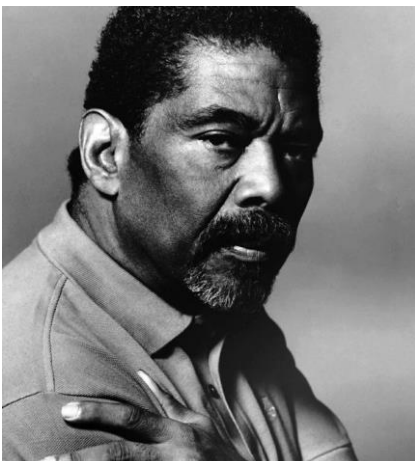
What can I watch on Dance Online?

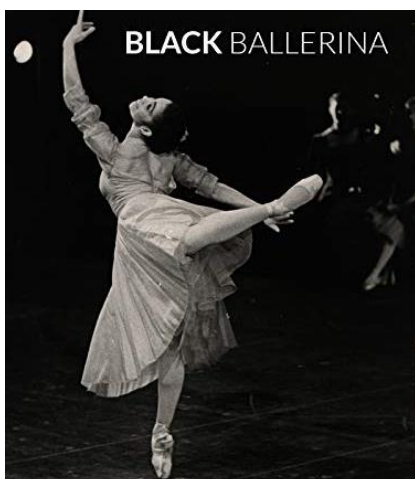
