All students & staff at NSCD can access the library catalogue via any device with internet access.


## How can I access Heritage?

Students from NSCD can access the OPAC through the Library & Archive pages on <u>Moodle</u> and <u>OpenAthens</u>.




### How do I search for an item?

Unlike search engines such as Google, Heritage will only find results for items matching your exact search terms. So ensure all spelling is correct and you enter a clear search term.


