

# CYPDNN Children's Programme 2022-2023

Dance has an important role to play for children and young people's well-being. The impact of dance is educational, offers health benefits, impacts well-being and encourages emotional expression and creativity. The CYPDNN was set up to broaden the dance offer to children and young people across the North and strengthen the voice of the sector. Aiming to advocate for and promote dance through partnership. The network provides high quality networking opportunities, coordinates training and professional development sessions and shares dance activity across the north. CYPDNN believes that by working together we will ensure children and young people have the same opportunities wherever they live.

As part of the NSCD NPO funding for extension year 2022 – 2023 CYPDNN created a Children's Programme that allowed for activity for CYP in dance in areas of special interest, need, gaps in provision or as part of levelling up for culture areas. The programme worked with multiple partners from across the North of England and directed, co-ordinated and part funded a number of initiatives in children and young people's dance.

#### Who were the partners?

The partners for the Children's Programme included local authorities' arts development and libraries teams (East Riding of Yorkshire, North Lincolnshire), dance/theatre companies Coalesce Dance Theatre, Hawk Dance Theatre, The Knotted Project and Sonia Sabri and Blaize touring schemes ArtERY and LiveLincs rural touring, Spot On and Culturapedia alongside the National Rural Touring Forum TAIL project (Touring Arts In Libraries). The Children's Programme also worked alongside NSCD L&P teams and with the York and North Yorkshire Dance Network collaborating on Dance It Up North in Scarborough at the YMCA. CYPDNN also linked with Yorkshire Schools Dance Festival held in York and created activities and research around CYP Voice during the period of the YSDF.


#### Where did the Children's Programme take place?

The Children's Programme offered activity and input to areas across The North of England, particularly focussing on Lancashire, The East Riding of Yorkshire, North Lincolnshire, Scarborough and YSDF in York with groups from across Yorkshire. There was an emphasis on taking dance to areas of low engagement with these being both urban and rural areas. The programme included dance theatre performances and engagement for children and young people and their families in collaboration with a range of partners and across a wide range of spaces including: libraries, museums, village halls, YMCA, hubs, school halls and outdoor spaces.



# Which dance companies collaborated and were engaged in the Children's Programme?

The CYPDNN Children's Programme focussed on supporting dance artists and companies from across The North of England who were creating, testing or adapting their work for CYP/Family audience. With capacity we were able to support companies with their funding bids, research and development phase, testing work with CYP in NSCD Saturday provision, local schools and libraries as well as ideas around promotion, marketing and finding venues for their work. In collaboration with our range of partners we also supported Northern touring for these companies. This included working with Hawk Dance Theatre and the Knotted Project (Inside The Igloo Live), Coalesce Dance Theatre (The Old Green Time Machine/PANTS R&D), Rachel Dean Dance (Thumbelina) and Sonia Sabri Dance. CYPDNN were able to work with partners to access the TAIL (Touring Arts In Libraries) project and collaborate to test and tour work into library spaces across the North. A short film was created by Blaize that highlights some of the early dance theatre touring work that took place in libraries in 2022.

In addition we supported an online Dance Get-Together presentation and session on Dance Touring for CYP in the North where we could look at models of good practice, hear from funders and programmers, learn from the experience of companies and share networks and knowledge for members and non members.
