National Portfolio Funding (Arts Council) - Children's Programme Activity & Artist Development 2023-2024

The Children & Young People's Dance Network North (CYPDNN) is a part of the Northern School of Contemporary Dance 's (NSCD) Arts Council funded National Portfolio Organisation (NPO).

In addition to its role in facilitating networking opportunities and coordinating professional development within the North, the CYPDNN also provides a Children's Programme. NSCD's NPO also prioritises artist development for companies interested in creating work for, by, and with children and young people.

Throughout 2023-2024, we provided support to artists and companies from the North by aiding in their funding applications, facilitating research and development initiatives, and conducting pilots both within NSCD and in collaboration with our strategic partners across the region. Additionally, we contributed to rural, library, and other touring activities in various levelling up areas, while also engaging in participatory projects across the North.

In 2023-24 NSCD also prioritised performances for CYP and their families both in house at The Riley Theatre in Leeds and at a wide variety of venues across the North. In this report we aim to highlight some of these activities as part of our NSCD NPO.

Who were the strategic partners in 2023-2024?

We continued to develop partners across the region and have had successful co-funded approaches with several local authorities including;

- East Riding Council
- East Riding Libraries
- North Lincolnshire Council
- North Lincolnshire Library/Hubs

Artists and companies supported in this year have included;

- Speedwell Dance
- Hawk Dance Theatre & The Knotted Project
- Coalesce Dance Theatre

All of whom have had opportunities created from R&D, sharing to potential bookers and programmers as well as fellow creatives, testing work with CYP and their families and occasional dates to perform through to multiple date tours in a variety of venues including schools, theatre spaces, libraries and hubs.

We also worked alongside Balbir Singh Dance Company (BSDC) to offer testing of their work Dewey and Indian Biscuits with children and their families in North Bridlington and Beverley.

Through partnership approaches we offered performance opportunities to young dancers in events in York Theatre Royal (Everybody Dances) working with York Dance Space and the North Yorkshire & York Dance Hub and at The Forum in Northallerton (Dance It Up North) where participants were able to view the premiere of Coalesce Dance Theatre's 'PANTS' following recruitment of new artists and a development of their initial work that we supported in early research phases in the previous year.

We continued our links to rural touring promoters and schemes in this year, with particular relationships continuing to develop with Blaize Community Arts (ArtERY & Live Lincs) and Spot On in Lancashire. Our partnership in Scarborough included Boys Dance work with The Brave Project and we delivered Collingham Collide, a programme for boys dance at Cottingham High School in the East Riding of Yorkshire. Where did the CYP and Families work take place in 2023-2024?

The activity was spread across the region in 2023-2024 with some priority areas continuing. Our main performance and participatory activities took place in Leeds (Hillcrest School/ NSCD Riley Theatre, NSCD Saturday Provision families), North Lincolnshire (Scunthorpe, Brigg, Baysgarth, Ashby), East Riding of Yorkshire (Withernsea, Beverley, North Bridlington, Cottingham, Bridlington, Market Weighton), York (Theatre Royal York), North Yorkshire (Scarborough, Northallerton), Lancashire (Roman Road Library, Edgeworth, Burnley) as well as in Shrewsbury with Arts Alive at Theatre Severn (testing work with SEN families) and at Boston Spa Auditorium as part of an ongoing NSCD partnership with Boston Spa Academy in West Yorkshire. Activity included performances, participatory experiences and workshops as well as pilot and extract testing and research and development with CYP. Our partners and venues were varied and activity took place in a variety of spaces from indoor, outdoor, libraries, halls, schools, studios and reading rooms, theatre foyers and hubs.

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Artist Development with companies in the North

Partnerships established across the North to broaden opportunities for touring.

Partnerships have been made between NSCD and Burnley Words Festival, Northern Consortium of Rural Touring Schemes (ArtERY, Live Lincs, Spot On, Arts Out West, Highlights Rural Touring, Cheshire Rural Touring Arts, Culturapeadia, Rural Arts, Arts Alive) Theatre Severn Shropshire, Scarborough Stephen Joseph Theatre, Scarborough YMCA, Theatre Royal York, York Dance Space, Libraries as venues across East Riding of Yorkshire, Lancashire and North Lincolnshire, RTDI Rural Touring Dance Initiative and local community connections with Clay and Wharf Chambers. These connections make important opportunities for touring across the North of England in a variety of venues of varying sizes and for a wide variety of audiences.

Hawk Dance Theatre & The Knotted Project have benefited from input across the NPO Activity including showcases and performances at Burnley Mechanics Institute, East Riding of Yorkshire ArtERY and East Riding Libraries NPO through ERYC, touring in North Lincolnshire through Blaize Rural Touring and Live Lincs, North Lincs Council and NLC Libraries including with National Literacy Week and Community Hubs in Ashby & Scunthorpe.

To provide bespoke mentoring support and development packages for dance artists at any stage in their career across 2023-2024 To work with existing and connect with new partners/organisations to maximise opportunities, longevity, and impact to support artists to develop sustainable practices in the North & beyond.

Artist Development Package 1 – Hawk Dance Theatre & The Knotted Project

The company was successful with their recent ACE bid that we have supported as partner and in addition have been successful with a further bid to the Four National International Fund with partners NSCD, Blaize, NEAT (Scotland) and Atlantic Presenters Association (Canada) the bid was brought together with partners and supports the companies work being tested and performed in Scotland and Canada in 2024. The Greatest Robot will be performed in our partner school at Boston Spa auditorium in February and again in Baysgarth North Lincolnshire in partnership with NLC and North Lincolnshire Libraries.

Artist Development Package 2 – Speedwell Dance Thumbelina & May and the Mountain Witch

Activity has included a half day in the studio to re rehearse the show extracts and a 20 minute showcase on January 12th at the Northern Dance Get Together – to 65 audience/attendees.

Artist Development Package 3 – Coalesce Dance Theatre PANTS

Coalesce Dance Theatre have benefited from input from across the NPO Activity including performances at Burnley Words Fest in June 2023 and with the Northern Consortium of Rural Touring Schemes (East Riding of Yorkshire ArtERY, Spot On Rural Touring, Burnley Mechanics Institute) and have new partnerships for their work.

The company was successful with their recent ACE bid which is supported by NSCD as partner. Activity recently has included joint meetings with East Riding Youth Dance, East Riding Council, Montgomery Theatre Sheffield and North Lincolnshire libraries to facilitate some performances and engagement with CYP. The company performed twice as part of our partner event Everybody Dances York at York Theatre Royal (November 2023), spreading the message of taking care of yourself and good mental health. They also performed 'PANTS' twice and led workshops with Secondary aged young people at Dance It Up North Northallerton in March 2024.

BSDC Balbir Singh Dance Company

Having been approached by BSDC to help make links to the regions libraries in order to test the company work 'Dewey' we were able to work with partners at Blaize and East Riding Libraries to set up a day in March 2023 at North Bridlington Library and bring in two school groups to view and engage with the work. Further performances may now happen following this initial opportunity. Links were also made with strategic partners by email and zoom which then led to an opportunity for pop up performance of Indian Biscuits and Tea on Village Greens. This took place in Beverley on 30 March and performed to audiences of CYP and their families.

Continued Professional Development and Networking

Dance Mamas Live & Online July 2023

Dance Mama Live! Was piloted in 2019 and in 2023 the team partnered with us at NSCD to provide a Dance Mama Live! In Leeds at NSCD. The event was hybrid both in person and online options were offered. The event presented an adults workshop with Hannah & Drew Wintie Hawkins of Yorkshire Dance Space and a Children's performance of Hawk Dance Theatre & The Knotted Projects *The Greatest Robot Ever*. There was a webinar with a live audience with Balbir Singh and Anna Ehnold-Danailov.

The Northern Dance Get Together

The Northern Dance Get Together at NSCD (January 12, 2024) was a networking event that brought together dancers, choreographers, participation and learning officers and other industry professionals from across the North of England. The event attendance was 70 people from a range of dance companies, NPOs, and venues as well as freelancers from a range of genres and contexts from the North West, North East and Yorkshire regions.

Key themes of the event included fostering collaboration and innovation within the northern dance community, addressing challenges such as access to training and performance opportunities, and advocating for the recognition and support of dance as a vital art form in the region. Discussions also revolved around the development of a cohesive dance strategy for the North of England, with an emphasis on nurturing talent, workforce development, promoting diversity and inclusivity, male-identifying dance both in work and learning and participation and enhancing the visibility of northern dance on a regional and national scale.






The day included workshops from Carnival dance with RJC to Break dance with the Primal Instincts Crew and showcases including May and The Mountain Witch (Speedwell Dance) and Primal Instincts Crew.

Moving forward, participants at the Get Together expressed a commitment to continued dialogue and collaboration, with the aim of establishing a unified dance strategy that addresses the needs and aspirations of the northern dance community. This includes initiatives to enhance training and professional development opportunities, create platforms for showcasing northern talent, and advocate for increased funding and support for dance at a regional and national level. The CYPDNN strategy is informed by members from across the North and this event fed into strategy and next steps.

The Northern Dance Get Together at NSCD was a catalyst for driving positive change and sustainable development within the northern dance sector through collaboration, strategy and actions across the North.


